REFUSE

Due to the changeover of the refuse contract from Chet Smith to LaVern Hamm of Hesston, the residential trash pickup date will be changed from Saturday to Thursday, beginning the Thursday after Thanksgiving on December 5. The new rates will be as follows: \$5.25 for single family dwellings, and \$3.25 for senior citizens (will be determined by income). Senior citizens currently receiving discounted trash will be sent a letter, which must be returned by December 19, to determine eligibility.

MAIN STREET - MISSOURI PACIFIC RAILROAD CROSSING

The Kansas Department of Transportation has approved funding for the construction of flashing signal lights, cantilever type for the Main Street railroad crossing. The sources for funding will be 90% federal and 10% local. The funding will be available in 1987.

SUMP PUMP DRAINAGE

Section 1 of Article 5 of Ordinance #391 states:

No person shall discharge or cause to be discharged any stormwater, surface water, groundwater, roof runoff, subsurface drainage, including interior and exterior foundation drains, uncontaminated cooling water, or unpolluted industrial process waters to any sanitary sewer.

SIDEWALK CONSTRUCTION

The City of Whitewater, through grant funds received from the Department of Housing and Urban Development, is constructing a sidewalk along the west side of South Main. The sidewalk will benefit the residents of Wheat State Manor. Construction is hoped to be completed by December 2, 1985.
