Meeting Highlights from 7/22/24

- A Victory Sweeper was able to do a demo on Whitewater streets. It was determined that it was not built for the initial needs to clean up our streets but would be good for the continued clean-up once they were cleaned. The council desires to see more options and did not choose to purchase the unit from Victory Sweeper.
- Pope's Concrete has finished the Phase 1 Sidewalk project and it looks and functions great!
- AT&T will be bringing upgrades to their tower in October.
- IDEATEK has received approval for their grant from the State to bring Elbing, Burns, and the Whitewater Area their high-speed internet fiber options. Visit ideatek.com for more information.
- The city office has received a few complaint forms, which can be found at the city office or online: whitewaterks.gov, concerning varying issues of violations or non-compliance of city codes. Because the official forms are being used the city can begin investigating the issues presented.
- Lead/Copper Surveys are coming in but a lot more must be turned in, ASAP. This is required by the State of Kansas.
- The fire department has been doing hydrant testing and some of them are a bit slow to shut off completely and will leak for a while.
- The City Building yard project is planned to be looking good by Festival time.
- BUDGET HEARING will be Aug. 26 at 7:00pm with the City Council meeting directly after.






Whitewater River Consolidated Fire District



The months of June and July have not slowed down for the fire department. We had eighteen calls in June and seventeen calls in July. The department has responded to a lot of medical calls, several vehicle accidents and a grass fire throughout the fire district. We also responded to a mutual aid in Sedgwick for a structure fire and several other mutual aid and automatic aid calls to surrounding agencies.

Many have probably noticed the reduced water pressure on the evenings of July 17th and August 7th, this was due to hydrant flushing and testing during our fire drills. This is normally done once a year to ensure the hydrants are working efficiently and correctly. We also flushed and tested the hydrants in Elbing on July 17th.

The Whitewater River Consolidated Fire District was also invited to participate in the library's event again this year by providing a very large water sprinkler for the kids to play in. Kids of all ages were there to play in the water and cool off. We even had a little Princess show up to help spray some water. **Thank You** to the Whitewater Memorial Library for letting us participate again this year. It was a fun time for ALL.



The Whitewater River Consolidated Fire District extends our condolences to the family of fallen firefighter Ty Voth. Ty's father retired from the Newton Fire Department and was the Fire Chief in Whitewater for a short time. Ty also had numerous family ties to the Whitewater Community. Our thoughts and prays are with the Voth family in their time of mourning.

Backpack Safety Tips:

- Match your child's size to the backpack. Bigger is not better. The bottom of the backpack should go from waist level to 1-2 inches below the shoulder.
- Pick a backpack with two padded shoulder straps and a waist or chest strap. Use them all!
- Pack the bag so that most of the weight is at the curve of your child's lower back.
- Backpacks shouldn't weigh more than 15% of your child's body weight. That means a child who weighs 100 pounds should not have a backpack that weighs more than 15 pounds.
- If your child has to lean forward to support the backpack's weight, it's too heavy.



PIPE IDENTIFICATION HELPFUL TIPS:



Lead Pipe

- A magnet will not stick to a lead pipe.
- Scratch the pipe with a coin. If the scraped area is shiny silver and flakes off, the service line is lead.




Copper Pipe

- A magnet will not stick to a copper pipe.
- Scratch the pipe with a penny. If the scraped area is copper in color, like a penny, your service line is copper.



Galvanized Steel Pipe

- If a magnet sticks to the surface, your service line is galvanized steel.
- A scratch test is not needed. If you scratch the pipe, it will remain a dull gray.


