Whitewater River Consolidated Fire District



The Whitewater River CFD responded to 19 calls for service in the month of March, 13 calls for April and 25 calls for May. This year we have responded to a variety of calls including about 26 call that we have assisted our neighboring fire departments with Automatic Aid and Mutual Aid. We have received Automatic Aid and Mutual Aid for approximately 18 calls from our neighboring fire departments.

During structure fires, it is not unusual to receive Automatic Aid and/or Mutual Aid from 4 to 6 different fire departments. Without these Automatic Aid and Mutual Aid Agreements, our fire department and most of the other surrounding fire departments would not have the manpower or water supply to mitigate the calls for service we respond to.

The past two rural structure fires in Whitewater's response area have required numerous surrounding fire departments assistance with manpower and water supply. The structure fire in the first part of March required approximately 33,000 gallons of water to be delivered to the scene via tanker shuttle, which included Newton Fire/EMS, Sedgwick Fire, Walton Fire, Halstead Fire, Hesston Fire and Whitewater's two tenders. Most of these tankers made several trips to resupply with water that morning.

The structure fire towards the end of April requested approximately 15,000 gallons of water to be delivered to the scene via tankers. Departments that assisted on this fire were Newton Fire/EMS, Walton Fire, Sedgwick Fire and Benton Fire.

Most volunteer department are lacking in volunteers just like Whitewater River CFD is, so it is imperative to have good Mutual Aid and Automatic Aid Agreements as well as good working relationships with our surrounding departments. Without the help of our neighbors, we could not do our jobs safely, effectively and efficiently.

The Whitewater River Consolidated Fire District purchased a new Zoll AED in August of 2023 purchased with memorial money and donations. We recently received a Memorial in the name of Robert (Allan) Lister who passed April 2, 2024. Allan Lister, as most of us knew him as, served the Whitewater River Consolidated Fire District from January of 2004 through December 2006. He also served on the Wichita Fire Department for several years in the early 1960's.

The Whitewater River Consolidated Fire District Volunteers decided to purchase another AED with money received from Allan Lister's Memorial as well as other Memorial money received in the past. Thank You to the Lister Family as well as Families from previous Memorials for keeping the Fire Department in mind. These are pieces of equipment we hope we never have to use but recently our other AED has been used way too often.



If you (male or female) are interested in volunteering a few hours a month, feel free to stop by the District Office, come to a fire drill or call (316) 799-2121 to see what it's all about. Our fire drills are the 1st and 3rd Wednesday of each month at 7pm, either at the District Office or the Whitewater Fire Station.



This form is to help the city meet the requirements set by the State of Kansas & KDHE (Kansas Department of Health & Environment).

Every city in Kansas is required to develop a **Lead Service Line Inventory (LSLI)** and submit this inventory to KDHE by a deadline set for October 2024.

When you fill out & return the form to the city; that assists City Maintenance as they compile that information into an inventory for our city.

If we have not received a form from you by the end of August we will deliver a form to your house.
