Council had much discussion regarding Newton Fire/EMS contract. Motion was made to not accept the Newton Fire/EMS contract, as presented January 1, 2024. Motion denied 0-3. Mayor Gragg and Council member, Jeff Artman will contact the county to get more information regarding EMS. 2024 Budgets for Park & Recreation and Whitewater Memorial Library were presented to the city council. City received radar speed signs to be posted on Elm St., Central and Main St. The mayor presented an email regarding a site for commercial retail store in Whitewater with questions of being annexed into the city limits. Tabled until June. He also presented a letter of resignation of City Treasurer, Sue Archer and will need to look at new appointment. Council approved of Don purchasing a new product to help with root control for city sewer. KDHE had come and pleased with city records. City Clerk, Heather Thiel shared that many letters had gone out to residents regarding tall grass/mowing. New quotes for pest control and quotes for new phone service for the city.

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WASTE CONNECTIONS
Citywide Summer Clean-up
Saturday, July 29th - 7:30 am-Noon

Waste Connections will make one pass thru the city.
Items must be brought to the street for curbside pickup
Waste Connections requests all items to be collected
be set at the curb prior to 7:30am, July 29th

Waste Connections asks that all items being collected need to be able to be handled by two people safely. General trash, small amounts of bundled brush or limbs, furniture including, chairs, couches, tables. Appliances including, washers, dryers, dishwashers, microwaves, small electrical appliances such as TV's, computers, mixers, blenders. Patio grills, patio furniture, push lawn mowers (free of gas & oil) and lawn trimmers. Tree limbs and branches must be cut in 3 foot lengths and bundled for easy pickup. Any trash not in the trash cart must be in throwaway containers such as boxes or bags, no more than 30-gallon capacity. No loose trash or debris will be picked up, or box or bag exceeding 40 pounds in weight.

Here is a list of items NO LANDFILL OR TRANSFER STATION will accept:

Car batteries, oil filters, fluorescent light bulbs, propane tanks, any asbestos materials, explosives, paint (we will take empty & dried up paint cans), no hazardous liquids (such as fertilizers, pesticides, herbicides, solvents, diesel fuel, gas, oil, transmission fluid, antifreeze, etc.) tires. REFRIGERATORS, FREEZERS AND AIR CONDITIONERS must be tagged by a technician and must have the appropriate paper work with it in order for Waste Connections to pick it up.

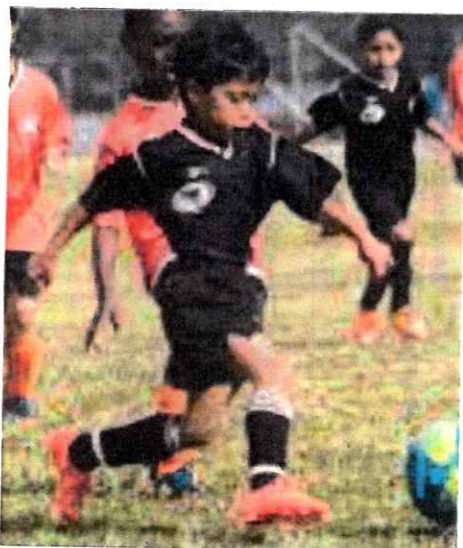

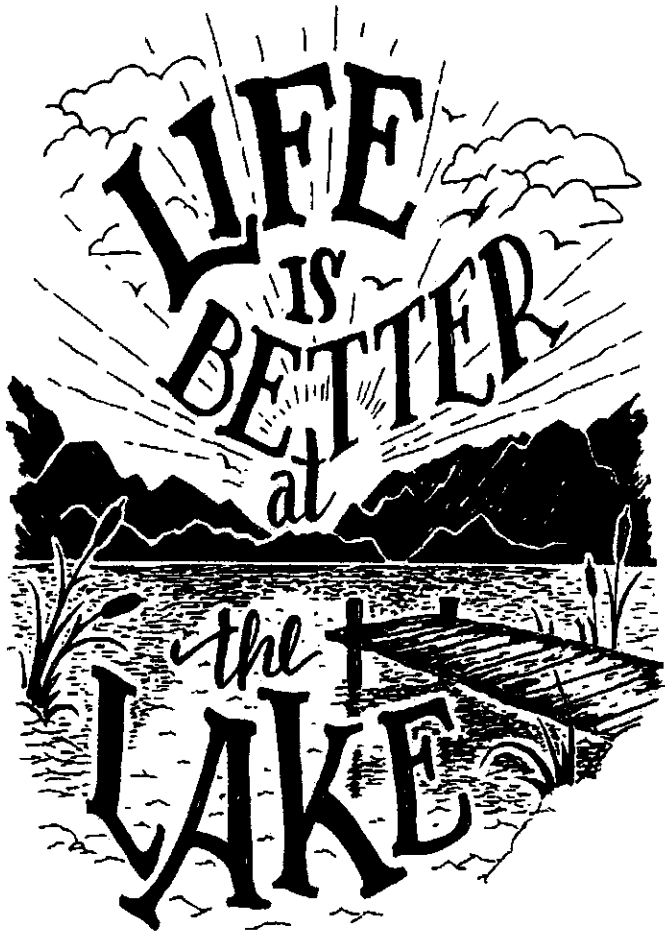

Day 1, December 5, 2023: Departure
