

RESOLUTION No. 0825-25B

A Resolution Allocating Utility Late Fee Revenues to the Sewer Reserve Fund

WHEREAS, the City of Whitewater currently imposes a 10% late fee on delinquent utility payments as outlined in the city's utility rate policies;

WHEREAS, the City recognizes the importance of maintaining and improving its sewer infrastructure to ensure public health, environmental protection, and long-term sustainability;

WHEREAS, the establishment and reinforcement of the Sewer Reserve Fund is essential for future capital improvements, emergency repairs, and compliance with state and federal regulations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHITEWATER, KANSAS:

- 1. Effective retroactively to January 1, 2025, all revenues collected from utility payment late fees shall be credited directly to the Sewer Reserve Fund.
- 2. The City Treasurer shall ensure that all applicable late fee revenues are transferred monthly to the Sewer Reserve Fund and properly documented in the city's financial records.
- 3. This resolution shall remain in effect until amended or repealed by future council action.
- 4. The City Clerk is hereby directed to update all relevant financial procedures and notify the public of this change via the city website and utility billing statements.
