

### **ORDINANCE NO. 638**

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PUBLIC OFFENSES AND TRAFFIC OFFENSES WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF WHITEWATER, KANSAS; INCORPORATING BY REFERENCE THE 2024 STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE FOR KANSAS CITIES 51ST EDITION AND THE 2024 UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE FOR KANSAS CITIES 40TH EDITION, PUBLISHED IN 2024; PROVIDING CERTAIN PENALTIES, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NUMBERS 633 AND 634 OF THE CITY OF WHITEWATER, KANSAS.

# BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WHITEWATER, BUTLER COUNTY, KANSAS:

### SECTION I. INCORPORATING STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE.

There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating traffic within the corporate limits of the City of Whitewater, Kansas, that certain standard traffic ordinance known as the "Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities, 51<sup>th</sup> Edition" prepared by and published in 2024 by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas.

## SECTION II. INCORPORATING UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE.

There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating public offenses within the corporate limits of the City of Whitewater, Kansas, certain code known as the "Uniform Public Offense Code for Kansas Cities, 40<sup>th</sup> Edition" prepared and published in 2024 in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas.

## SECTION III. MAINTAINING COPIES

A copy of the 51<sup>th</sup> Edition of the Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities and the 40<sup>th</sup> Edition of the Public Uniform Offense Code for Kansas Cities shall be marked or stamped "Official Copy as Adopted by Ordinance No. 638", and to which shall be attached a copy of this ordinance to each published copy, and filed with the city clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours.

### SECTION IV. REPEAL

Ordinance No. 633 & 634 of the City of Whitewater, Kansas are hereby repealed.

### SECTION V. EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the BUTLER COUNTY TIMES GAZETTE, the official newspaper of said City.
